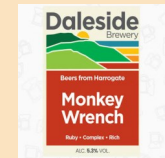


ISLE OF WIGHT STEAM RAILWAY



Abbeydale Brewery — Sheffield

Deception **4.1%** **GF/V** **PALE ALE**
A pale beer, made with fabulous Nelson Sauvin hops. Aromas of elderflower and grapes. Strong citrus flavours, especially grapefruit. Long lasting bitter finish. Very refreshing and packed full of flavour.

Atom Brewery — Hull

Hubble **3.8%** **PALE ALE**
A hazy pale ale hopped with Citra, Nelson and Strata for a grapefruit and passion fruit finish.

Black Bear Brewery — Taunton

RCH Pitchfork **4.3%** **GOLDEN**
Pale golden coloured ale with some hops on the nose. Flavours combine light malt with a citric hop bitterness leaving a lasting bitter and dry aftertaste.
Wiveliscombe Heritage **4.5%** **GOLDEN**
Golden Original pays homage to Wiveliscombe’s long brewing history. Fresh herbal, citrus, and floral aromas, and a bittersweet finish.

Brew 61 — Bromsgrove

Grazing Girls **4.5%** **GOLDEN**
A ripe tropical fruit aroma, a big hoppy taste, and a clean, light bitter finish.

Brewsters — Grantham

Aromantica **4.2%** **BITTER**
A touch of roast malt for a light amber brew with a slightly sweet nutty flavour. Citra hops to the fore give tropical hop notes and aromas of lime and passion fruit with a refreshingly long aromatic finish.

Bridges — Nottingham

Lady Bay **4.3%** **PALE ALE**
A smooth, session pale ale brewed with a perfect blend of the finest British and American hops.

Castle Rock — Nottingham

Strange Charm **4.1%** **GF/V** **IPA**
It is both vegan and gluten-free, and is crafted to offer tropical stone fruit and citrus characteristics on cask.

Cerne Abbas — Dorset

Gurt Coconuts Rum Stout **6.7%** **STOUT**
Rich, Sweetness, Coconuts, Rum—does what it says on the tin!

Cerne Abbas — Dorset

Legless Jester **4.7%** **GOLDEN PALE**
Golden, bright pale ale with aromas of fresh fruit and resinous hops. Crisp, bitter orange and marmalade flavour, followed by a dry, floral finish with a hint of melon. Long-lasting bitterness and a zingy, very drinkable.

Daleside — Harrogate

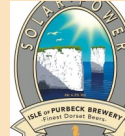
Monkey Wrench **4.2%** **BITTER**
Darker than normal for a bitter, almost Ruby Brown, the main malt characteristic is present throughout the beer with some caramel especially in the taste. There is some bitterness preventing the beer from being too sweet and a presence of vine fruit too.

Exmoor — Devon

Gold **4.5%** **GOLDEN ALE**
Golden “single malt “ ale. Juicy malt aroma with a hint of vanilla and citric hops. Starts bitter sweet in the mouth and finishes dry and hoppy.

Glastonbury — Somerset

Arthurs Ale **3.4%** **V** **BITTER**
This amber bitter is easy drinking with a subtle orange aroma.



Goddards Brewery — Sandown Isle of Wight

GSB **4.0%** **BITTER**
Refreshingly, clean, easy–drinking bitter, with a wonderful aroma of freshly rubbed hops that carries through to a satisfying aftertaste.

Fuggle Dee Dum **4.8%** **DARK BITTER**
Chestnut–coloured strong ale with a deep hoppy taste, walnut bitterness with a rounded malty counter. Hints of caramel and roast add depth as a piquant blackcurrant sweetness filters through.

Green Jack — Lowestoft

Trawlerboys **4.6%** **BITTER**
Tawny premium bitter with a sweet aroma of malt plus hints of caramel, plum and red fruit. A full bodied malty and fruity sweetness in the mouth with a sticky mouthfeel and a layer of hop bitterness providing contrast and holding up well in the strong finish.

Island Brewery — Shalfleet Isle of Wight

Wight Gold **4.0%** **BITTER**
A golden brown bitter brewed with rounded Crystal malt & hops throughout.

Vectis Venom **4.8%** **BITTER**
Malty, dark ruby red ale with and easy drinking and underlying smooth characteristic.

Isle of Purbeck — Dorset

Solar Power **4.3%** **GOLDEN ALE**
Tawny mid-range ale brewed using Continental hops. Well-balanced flavours combine to provide a strong bitter taste but short, dry finish.

Full Steam Ahead **4.8%** **BITTER**
Mid-brown beer with hop/malt balance in the flavour and a long dry aftertaste.

Kirkstall — Leeds

Conchord **4.0%** **IPA**
New England style hazy IPA.

Magpie — Nottingham

Cherry Raven **4.4%** **STOUT**
Magpie's stout flavoured with cherry. Bitter Cherry is the dominant flavour, but not that strong on the nose.

Nene Valley — Oundle

Egyptian Cream **4.5%** **GF** **STOUT**
Milk Stout with a velvety mouthfeel and a deep, full richness created with a range of malts and flaked oats with a little extra lactose sweetness.

Palmer's Brewery — Bridport

Tally Ho! **5.5%** **OLD ALE**
A complex dark old ale with roast malts & treacle toffee on the palate, leading to a long lingering finish, with more than a hint of coffee. DING DONG!

Dorset Gold **4.5%** **GOLDEN**
More complex than many golden ales thanks to a pleasant banana and mango fruitiness on the aroma that carries on into the taste and aftertaste.

Pheantry — Newark

Black Pheasant **4.2%** **STOUT**
A smooth, soft. satisfying dark ale with malty flavours, balanced bitterness and a velvety texture.

Portobello — Kensington

Tropical Crush **4.4%** **SPECIALITY**
Strong passionfruit and mango aroma with some earthy hop notes. Sweet, slightly cloying fruit flavour with strong bitter undertones.



Salopian — Hadnall

Lemon Dream **4.5%** **SPECIALITY**
A light gold ale brewed with wheat malt and subtly flavoured with fresh lemons.

Three Kings — North Shields

Dark Side of the Toon **4.1%** **STOUT**
Dark roast malts and a sweet creamy body last through to a drier finish of roast bitter.

Tiny Rebel — Newport

Cosmic Pale **4.0%** **PALE ALE**
Citra hops session pale ale.

Two Dogs — Lincolnshire

Subliminal Citra **4.3%** **APA**
Hoppy, zesty citrus cask ale brewed by the newly launched Two Dogs Brewing in collaboration with Elgood’s Brewery.

Wensleydale — Leyburn

Yorkshire Day **3.9%** **PALE ALE**
Brewed specifically by Wensleydale Brewery to celebrate Yorkshire Day (August 1st). It features citrus and spice notes from Cascade and Cashmere hops.

Wightknuckle Brewery — Nunwell

Best **4.2%** **BITTER**
A classic traditional bitter, a flavour profile that has stood the test of time, soft body with notes of caramel and spice.

Gold Otter **4.2%** **GOLDEN**
Soft and quaffable, this traditional golden ale has a classic profile with notes of biscuit, honey and mild spice. It has a gentle bitterness.

Yates’ Brewery — Newchurch

Beachcomber **4.5%** **PALE ALE**
Straw coloured easy drinking summer ale with a distinctive fresh aroma and a clean, hoppy finish.

Don’t Look Back in Amber **4.4%** **BITTER**
An amber–coloured ale with a bittersweet aftertaste.
